Four Solings enjoyed full races in winds ranging from moderate to light with some dead spots. The dominate wind direction was out of the south. Conditions were sunny and quite warm.

Both aerators in the pond now were on though out our racing, but they did not seem to pose any real problems for us.

We took advantage of the shade trees near our new lock box. In order to be able to stay seated in the shade as much as possible, we used a start/finish extending from the top of the stair rail near us, over to a large tree on the opposite side of the pond. This did not allow for boats on course side after one minute to round the end of the line, so we discouraged dip starts, but did not worry if a boat was accidentally a bit late to get on the non-course side of the line.

The first two heats were sailed starting south, then to south center red, SE yellow, and then finish. All subsequent heats were sailed starting south, with the same two marks, then north to the center red, NW green, then finish. Lead changes kept things interesting.

Jay Livingston showed up at the pond with his DF-95, mistaking this to be a DF-95 event day. Not to let a skipper go to waste, John Clough got out the Soling that was recently donated to the club, and we got it sorted out so Jay could sail all the heats with us.

Lead changes and a few close finishes kept things interesting.

We checked out the new storage box was installed for us between posts to the north of our starting area. We evaluated a lock that John Clough happened to have on hand. I checked and found that the PVC tube for the Soling fleet Club banner and feather banner poles will fit in the box if it is placed diagonally.
